Hundreds of Students Join Marching Band Competition In the Jungle Waterpark

On Wednesdays & Thursdays, 16th & 17th of February 2016, hundreds of students ranging from kindergarten, elementary, to junior high school participating on marching band competition for Persatuan Drum Band Indonesia (PDBI) (PDBI) Cup West Java Province level, which held for the umpteenth time at the Jungle Waterpark, Bogor Nirwana Residence (BNR), the city of Bogor.

Marching band contest themed "Marching on the Jungle III" is a West Java level competition held by PDBI in cooperation with the Jungle Waterpark which is the theme park project of PT. Bakrieland Development Tbk (Bakrieland). The contest was attended by 30 participants from three provinces, namely: West Java, DKI Jakarta and Banten. For the two categories held on Wednesday, the category of kindergarten with 12 participants and the junior high school category with 2 participants. Meanwhile, for elementary school categories followed by 16 participants held on Thursday.

Chairman of PDBI West Java, Gatut Susanta said, for the event marching band PDBI 2016 held three times a year in hopes PDBI can build euphoria in marching band among kindergarten students to high schools throughout the region, especially West Java. Gatut revealed for the assessment of the competition involves four judges including 3 people from Bandung and 1 person from Yogyakarta. The winners of the competition are judged by the type of music played, the compactness, the creations, the number of participants and the color of playing the instrument and the collaboration of the competition.
