Employee Volunteers for Garut and Sumedang Disaster

On September 20, 2016, the Cimanuk river that cross Garut and Sumedang overflow due to high rainfall. As a result, the great flood swept all that were close to the river. Reported by Badan Nasional Penanggulangan Bencana (BPNP) as of 26 September 2016, 33 people were killed, 20 were missing, 35 were wounded, and 6,361 were displaced from their homes. Not to mention the loss of material such as the destruction of houses and public facilities.

In response to this disaster, volunteers from PT Bakrieland Development Tbk (Bakrieland) and its business unit moved quickly to help affected communities. This assistance is in the form of fundraising channeled through Bakrie Amanah Foundation (Bakrie Amanah), the program implementator of Bakrie Untuk Negeri (BUN), which has CSR Response program. Submission of donations was made on 23 September 2016.
