



CSR Program for Organic and Inorganic Waste Management at Bogor Nirwana Residence

The Bogor Nirwana Residence (BNR) area, managed by its subsidiary PT Graha Andrasentra Propertindo Tbk (GAP), has been collaborating since 2011 with local residents and the city government to manage waste based on the Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle (3R) principles. This collaboration is realized through the establishment of a Temporary Waste Disposal Site (TPS), which processes up to 30 tons of waste each month into useful products such as compost and raw materials for other plastic products.

On March 18, 2025, Bakrieland carried out a revitalization of the TPS facilities and infrastructure by upgrading the organic waste shredding equipment, refurbishing the office that will also function as a community meeting space, and improving the waste processing building.

For Bakrieland, this initiative represents an effort to realize Corporate Sustainability under the pillar "It's About the People," particularly in supporting community development in the environmental field.
